 The Social Work program will attempt to keep in contact with students through emails, phone calls, social media, and any other methods possible. We also have close connections to employers, and we will pursue information through them as well.

 SOC Code 1, 21.1093 (Social & Human Service Assistants) is listed on the In-Demand Occupations List at the ACHE website for 2023, with a total of 350 jobs opening each year. Additionally, the proposal comes from conversations with a variety of employers in the area, including Kids to Love, First Baptist Church Huntsville, the Veterans Administration, and other service organizations who need people to work under the supervision of social workers; they need employees with some knowledge in the field because of the highly sensitive nature of the work.

 Calhoun currently has approximately 100 Social Work majors, many of whom will go on to four-year programs. However, this program would allow them to work in their field while they continue their studies.
