




NOTE: National Student Clearinghouse Graduation Rate reports are based on similar IPEDS criteria, but also include students who transferred to any Alabama public or private institution, or transferred out of Alabama to continue their education and complete their postsecondary education. Students that transfer and graduate are included in the graduation rate of the original institution. This measure rewards a university for the success of transfer students.

Athens State University is an upper division institution and therefore is not included in this report.

Ingram State Technical College is comprised of incarcerated inmates and therefore is not included in this report.
