














## ACHE Summary of Fall Enrollment at Alabama Public Institutions from 1998 thru 2015 by Gender and Institution Type






Fall 2015 Enrollment in Alabama Public Colleges and Universities Including Students from Alabama and the Top 20 Feeder States









# Historical Summary of Fall Enrollment by Age at Alabama Public 4-Year Institutions from Fall 2005 thru Fall 2015

















# Historical Summary of Fall Enrollment by Age at Alabama Public 2-Year Institutions from Fall 2005 thru Fall 2015





- Have an articulation agreement with all the state's two year colleges that allows their students to seamlessly transfer to AAICU member colleges
- Enroll a higher percentage of "pell-grant" recipients than public four-year colleges

These 14 member colleges possess excellence in teaching and technology, low faculty-student ratios, high retention of students, and a unique, personal approach to education. These institutions teach students to master critical thinking skills, communicate effectively, gain an appreciation for the arts and humanities and a commitment to community service.



### **Message from General Paul Hankins**

AAICU is excited to include data this year from six of Alabama's independent institutions: Faulkner University, Huntingdon College, Judson College, Spring Hill College, United States Sports Academy, and the University of Mobile. Although participation in the Alabama Statewide Student Database by our member colleges is completely voluntary, by including our data, the state is able to paint a more complete picture of its higher education capacity for potential students, businesses, and economic development prospects.

AAICU schools account for 14% of Alabama's bachelor degrees and 24% of Alabama's professional degrees while producing over \$1.4B in direct economic impact within the state. In addition, we have a formal articulation agreement with all of the two year colleges in the state's Department of Postsecondary Education -- enabling their over 16,000 students a year who go on to four year colleges the ability to transfer seamlessly to our independent colleges throughout the state. Our schools continue to support this initiative to include our data and we intend to increase the number of schools participating in the coming year.
