









Following the Progress of Alabama Public High School Graduates As They Enroll in Alabama Public Colleges and Universities Fall Term after High School Graduation







ACHE Summary of Fall Enrollment at Alabama Public Institutions from 2002 thru 2016 by Gender and Institution Type





Fall 2016 Enrollment in Alabama Public Colleges and Universities Including Students from Alabama and the Top 20 Feeder States











Historical Summary of Fall Enrollment by Age at Alabama Public 4-Year Institutions from Fall 2007 thru Fall 2016




Historical Summary of Student Retention Rates Alabama Public 4-Year Institutions


Percentage of 1st Time Degree-Seeking Freshmen Returning for a Second Year













Historical Summary of Fall Enrollment by Age at Alabama Public 2-Year Institutions from Fall 2007 thru Fall 2016




Historical Summary of Student Retention Rates Alabama Public 2-Year Institutions

The Alabama Association of Independent Colleges and Universities (AAICU) promotes and protects the interests of independent higher education in Alabama and oversees scholarship fundraising efforts for students attending each of its fourteen member schools.

These 14 member colleges and universities:

- Employ almost 5,000 people
- Generate well over \$1.4 billion in economic impact each year
- Are attended by more than 24,000 students
- Provide some form of financial aid to over 92% of these students
- Offer a wide range of associate, bachelor, and graduate degree programs
- Have an articulation agreement with all the state's two year colleges that allows their students to seamlessly transfer to AAICU member colleges
- Enroll a higher percentage of "pell-grant" recipients than public four-year colleges

These 14 member colleges possess excellence in teaching and technology, low faculty-student ratios, high retention of students, and a unique, personal approach to education. These institutions teach students to master critical thinking skills, communicate effectively, gain an appreciation for the arts and humanities and a commitment to community service.

AAICU is governed by a Board of Directors, currently chaired by Rev. Dr. Cameron West, President of Huntingdon College. The Board is comprised of the college presidents of member institutions as well as business trustees from throughout the state. AAICU's president is Paul Hankins, and he is responsible for leading the association on a day to day basis.


Message from General Paul Hankins

AAICU is excited to include data this year from six of Alabama's independent institutions: Faulkner University, Huntingdon College, Judson College, Spring Hill College, United States Sports Academy, and the University of Mobile. Although participation in the Alabama Statewide Student Database by our member colleges is completely voluntary, by including our data, the state is able to paint a more complete picture of its higher education capacity for potential students, businesses, and economic development prospects.

AAICU schools account for 14% of Alabama's bachelor degrees and 24% of Alabama's professional degrees while producing over \$1.4B in direct economic impact within the state. In addition, we have a formal articulation agreement with all of the two year colleges in the state's Alabama Community College System (ACCS) -- enabling their over 16,000 students a year who go on to four year colleges the ability to transfer seamlessly to our independent colleges throughout the state. Our schools continue to support this initiative to include our data and we intend to increase the number of schools participating in the coming year.


